How to Change Who Can Send Me Snaps

Tap icon on the camera screen.

Tap icon (Settings) on your Profile in the top right corner.

Scroll down to see “Who Can...” and tap “Contact Me.”

Tap “My Friends” or “Everyone” to update who can contact you.

Please note: Selecting “Everyone” allows anyone to send you Snaps, even if you haven’t added them to your friends list.

Save your selection by tapping the back button.

How to Change Who Can See My Story

Tap icon on the camera screen.

Tap icon (Settings) on your Profile in the top right corner.

Scroll down to the “Who Can...” and tap “View My Story.”

Tap “My Friends” or “Everyone” to update who can view your Story.

Tap 'Custom' to block specific friends from viewing your Story.

Please note: Selecting everyone allows anyone to view your Story, even if you haven’t added them to your friends list.

Save your selection by tapping the back button.

Quick Tip:

Only users added to your friends list can send you Snaps, unless the “Everyone” permission settings is selected. If someone sends you a Snap that isn’t on your friends list, you will receive a notification, but be unable to see it unless you add them as a friend.

Make changes to the list in Settings.
